Part of this program is the engineering, supply of goods and installation works of heating sub-stations and accessories for District Heating Companies (Toplana’s) of Priboj and Mali Zvornik comprising of the following scope:

- Detailed design as required in accordance to the Serbian Law
- Deliveries and installation works for cca. 100 (specifically defined in the tender documents) indirect type compact substations and accessories
- Dismantling works of old equipment where replacement of old with new sub-station is foreseen
- Permitting procedures (if applicable)

The delivery scope includes entire compact substations, including but not limited to below listed equipment:

- Control Valves (Combination Valves and 2-Way Valves including Drives)

- Sensors for Temperature and Pressure
- Heat Exchangers
- Digital Control Units
- Pumps
- Armature (Balancing Valves, Check Valves, Ball Valves, Strainers/Filters, Draining/Venting Vessels, Venting Vessels)
- Expansion tanks
- Safety valves
- Measurement Devices (Manometers & Thermometers)
- Heat meters (including calibration and verification procedures in accordance with Serbian Law)

The scope comprises supply of the SCADA systems as well (hardware and software), installation, parameter setting and putting into operation including commissioning. The limits of the Contractors Scope are up to the block valves of the service connection pipes inside the buildings for connecting the DH substations.

The Commencement of the Works (signing of Contract) is expected in August 2020 and the Provisional Acceptance till January 2022.

This Pre-Qualification is open to eligible bidders who have experiences in engineering, supply and installation of district heating sub-stations and an annual turnover of $\geq 2.000.000$ EUR, single or as Joint Venture of maximum two entities. Further qualification requirements are specified in the Pre-Qualification Documents.
