The successful candidate will work to support human rights defenders, communities and civil society organisations in the European Union's Eastern Neighbourhood and Central Asia that are affected by the investments of international financial institutions (IFIs). The candidate will help these groups defend their rights to information, participation in decision making and a clean and healthy environment. The successful candidate will also contribute to policy advocacy with the IFIs on issues such as human rights due diligence, gender rights and accountability. Interest and experience with gender policy will be an asset for the successful candidate.

Job description:

- Maintain contacts with multilateral development banks' staff and independent complaint mechanisms on specific projects, as well as their environmental, human rights and gender policies
- Collect and disseminate information on the projects and policies of international financial institutions
- Work with communities and organisations in the European Union's Eastern Neighbourhood and Central Asia
- Support communities with requesting information, communicating their opinions and participating in the decision-making of multilateral development banks
- Support communities in dialogue with multilateral development banks' corporate clients
- Facilitate capacity building and skills sharing among communities and civil society partners through advising, developing training materials, analysing materials and developing solutions, and holding training events and field trips



Expectations of the candidate:

- Background in or experience with human rights, gender, public participation and accountability is preferred
- Experience in community development and support for activists and human rights defenders
- Experience with organising events
- Readiness to work both in a team and independently
- Knowledge of development issues and an affinity for the Bankwatch mission are preferred
- Familiarity with the region and experience with working in international organisations is an asset
- Readiness to travel regionally, once the situation allows
- Fluency and good writing skills in English are required
