Part of this program is the design, delivery, construction of biomass plant and connection to the new and existing district heating networks operated by the city of Novi Pazar, comprising of the following main components:

- Biomass storage facility
- Boiler house for biomass boiler and 2 backup boilers
- Biomass storage area for intermediate storage
- Facilities for providing the fuel of the backup natural gas boilers
- Traffic areas around buildings for unloading and manipulation of delivered biomass and picking-up of ash containers
- Access roads for delivery of biomass
